- How to Enter. Entry into the 2023 API Summit Hackathon must be made using the submission form at https://konghq.com/conferences/kong-summit/hackathon-signup. No purchase is necessary to enter. All valid entries must be received by Kong Inc. ("Kong") between 09:00 a.m. US Eastern time on August 28, 2023 and 5:00 p.m. US Eastern time on November 27, 2023 ("Entry Deadline"). Judges will consider the innovation, practicality, impactfulness, functionality, adherence to theme, and presentation of each entry. The entry with the highest total score will be the winning entry. In the event of a tie in overall score, the entry with the highest innovation points will win, and in the event of a continued tie, the entry with the highest points impactfulness will win.
